Item No. 1: Re-examination of Mid-Semester Test of B.A./B.Com. 2nd, 4th & 6th Semesters and M.A. (All Subjects) 2nd & 4th Semesters for the session 2018-19.

Keeping in view the decision of the committee in its meeting held on 20.02.2019, Five (05) applications for re-examination of MST were brought before the committee and the committee deliberated on each application. The decision of the committee with reasons is stated as under:

- 1. Prem Sarup, B.A. IInd Semester, Roll No. 494 has stated that he was to appear for the interview in Bhopal from 10th to 15th March, 2019. The committee **RESOLVED** that this case does not fit into the earlier approved decision. So, his application should not be allowed for re-examination of MST.
- 2. Bakshish Singh, B.A. IIIrd year, Roll No. 1319 has stated the reason of his absence as severe back pain but he has not stated that he was hospitalized or not. Exemption is given only to hospitalized students. Committee did not agree for his re-examination.
- 3. Himmat Singh, B.A. IIIrd year, Roll No. 1346 was hospitalized and was operated by a Doctor at Bathinda. He may be allowed for re-examination in the paper he could not appear.
- 4. Riddhika Dhir, M.A. (Economics) IInd Semester, Roll No. 2523 stated that her Father who is a senior navy officer was to be conferred AVSM award by the President of India on 19.03.2019. The entire family, as per father's written letter to the Chairperson, was invited by the President of India on that occasion. She may be allowed for reappear in the examination as a special case.
- 5. Sudha, M.A. (Economics) IVth Semester, Roll No. 2620 has stated that she was in her engagement function from 8th to 15th March, 2019 at Lucknow. The candidate has not provided any document or proof for the same. So, she may not be allowed for reexamination of MST.

It was further **RESOLVED** that no more applications for MST re-examination - 2019 will be entertained.

- (a) The committee discussed about the performance of duty by the faculty during the just concluded MST examination and appreciates the cooperation extended by all the faculty members. This is a case of sheer negligence on the part of the teacher.
