NOTICE

The students of MA English Semester IV (2021) are hereby informed that in accordance with the PU syllabus- guidelines, they have to opt for a fifth compulsory paper in Semester 4.

The course is titled - "Paper- XVIII: Skill Enhancement/ Social Outreach". In this course the students of DES-MDRC can opt for either the option of "Creative Writing" or "Translation". If they opt for "Creative Writing", they will have to submit to the Department office (soft as well as hard copies) of at least 5-7 poems, 2 short stories, or one chapter of a novel or write in some other genre of her/his own choice before the end of the semester. The hard copies of the writings produced by the students shall have to be maintained and placed in the library of the department.

If the students opt for "Translation", they shall be asked to translate 15-30 pages of an untranslated text either from Hindi to English or from Panjabi to English and submit their translation work to the Department office (soft and hard copies both) before the end of the Semester. The department shall hold a week long workshop for both the options - depending upon the option the students opt for. The hard copies of translations produced by the students shall have to be maintained and placed in the library of the Department. There will be no class-room teaching for the options cited above.
